#### **Entry Requirement**

To encourage more University students to join the dragon boat races, the entry requirement of the "Universities" category is clarified as follows:

#### Local Universities Invitational Races – Invited Teams Only

#### **Entry Requirement**

- Limited to the Education Bureau registered universities (including the City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, Lingnan University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, The University of Hong Kong, The Open University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Shue Yan University). Other higher education institutions are welcome to join various Local Championships.
- One team per university
- No gender limitation
- All participants must be students or staff of the universities in year 2013/2014
- Except for the steersman and drummer, each team must comprise of at least 50% students in each race
- Participants should provide a copy of their Student ID or staff ID

#### **International Grand Championships**

For standard boats only, the number of participating teams in the International Open, Mixed and Women Grand Championships will be limited to a total of 64, 32 and 16 teams respectively. All overseas applications received will be guaranteed a slot in the race. Other entries will be retained for local teams based on the best time in the **FIRST Race** of related local categories.

#### **Eligibility**

- 1. All overseas teams will be entitled to participate in respective Grand Championship categories.
- 2. The rest quota will be retained for local teams with the best time in the FIRST Race.

That is, in the event that only 30 overseas applications for the International Open Grand Championship are received by the submission deadline on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014, 34 local teams with the best time in the **FIRST Race** in respective local categories (please refer to table below for easy references), i.e. making it a total of 64 teams, will compete for the title of International Open Grand Championship.



#### **Crew Marquee Arrangement**

Crew resting area will be located at Mody Road Garden and UC Centenary Garden, please refer to the areas highlighted in yellow below.



Allocation of marquees will be arranged by balloting on Friday, 9 May 2014. **Marquee location may be changed after the draw subject to the actual venue setup conditions, please note.** Rental charge of the use of marquee is HK\$600 per marquee for 3 consecutive days. One club is eligible to apply for only one marquee \*.

Due to limited space, only 50 marquees are available for rent. Marquee and onsite location will be assigned on a first come first served basis. To confirm your place, payment on both the entry and marquee fee must accompany the entry forms. The floor plan of marquee setting will be announced later. Total number of marquees provided may vary subject to the actual venue setup conditions, please note.

Full refunds will be paid in the event of cancellation on or before <u>17 May 2014</u> via email to hkdba@hkolympic.org. For cancellation received on or after <u>18 May 2014</u>, 50% of the total cost of marquee rental will be reserved. To re-apply after cancellation, another HK\$600 will be imposed if there is still marquee available.

Kindly be reminded that unlawful occupation of unleased land and construction in public areas are illegal and punishable under the Laws of Hong Kong. Teams violated the Laws of Hong Kong will automatically be disqualified without notice and refund.



#### **Boat trial arrangement**

Boat trial sessions will be available at 9am to 11am on 6 June 2013 (Friday) for overseas teams.

A maximum of 8 standard boats will be provided in each session (at 30 minutes per session). Teams should reserve trial session in advance.

Please email reservation form to hkdba@hkolympic.org on or before 20 May 2014.

For safety concern and boat availability, walk-in for boat trial will not be entertained, please note.

Trial session will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. In case of overwhelming demand for boat trial, each team will be allocated with maximum 1 session (30 minutes) only.

Teams will receive reservation confirmation email from the Organising Committee on or before <u>28</u> May 2014.

Please print the confirmation email and present to the attending staff at boat trial. If teams are unable to present the confirmation email, staff will arrange boat trial according to the organizing committee's record.

#### **Provision of PFDs**

All the participants must be able to swim 100m in light clothing with NO buoyancy aid.

200 PFDs will be provided free of charge. **NO** advance reservation is required. Size and quantity are allocated on a first come, first served basis on the spot.

#### **Celebration Dinner**

HK\$3,500 will be charged per table for 12 persons. Detailed information of the celebration dinner will be announced in Bulletin (3).

Teams are welcomed to perform different kinds of performances such as magic show, jugglery, and dance during the celebration dinner.
